

Samaritans Promise

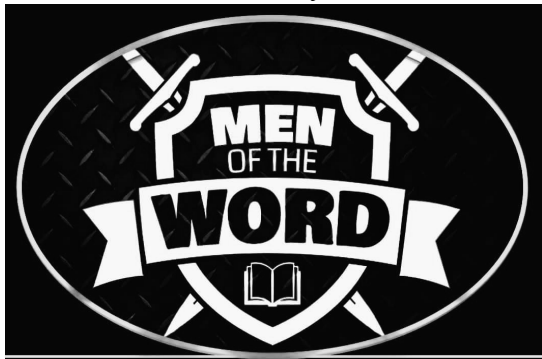
Serving those in need within the Tyrone and Bellwood areas

Walter Smith of *Men of the Word Ministries* is a retired pastor who



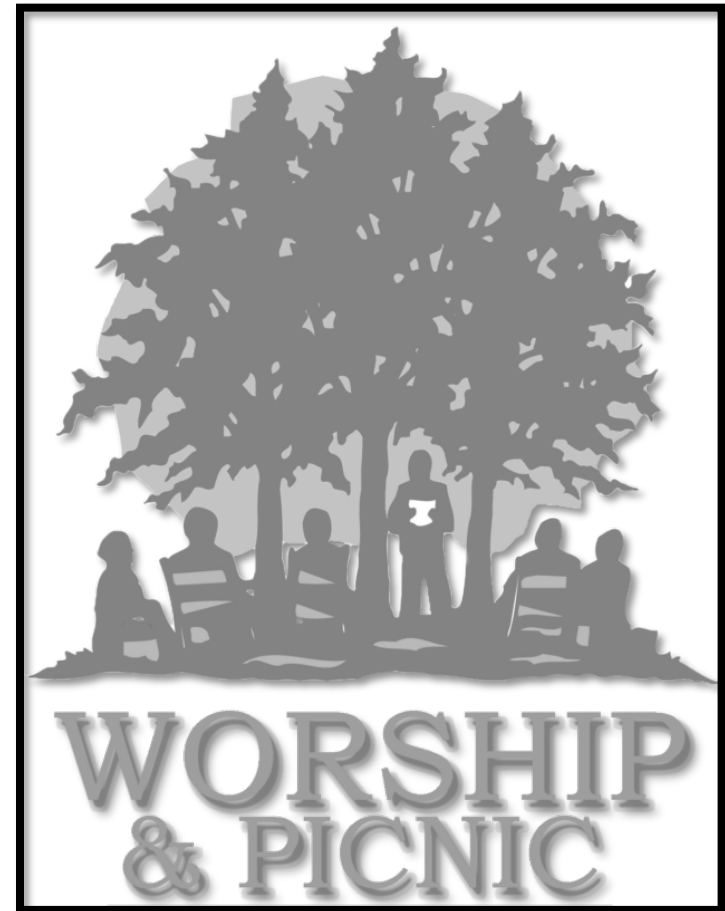
