Thank You! – Thank you everyone who donated Tide Pods and fabric softener to help the **Altoona Warming Center** – More than 50 unsheltered persons have found a warm and safe place to spend the night since the Warming Center opened on January 8 at Overflow Church in Altoona. In addition to safety and warmth, our guests are finding prayer partners, a listening ear, access to addiction and mental health counseling, job opportunities, physical health assessments, essential personal care items, information about meals and warming locations, a hearty breakfast, and hope in Jesus. About a dozen of our guests have become part of the Overflow Church family and are now regularly attending our community meal and Bible study as well as our Sunday services. More than 100 volunteers from area churches are participating in this effort with the assistance of agency personnel, city and county government, and the Altoona Fire Department. About a dozen people are on site each night serving between 15 and 20 unsheltered guests. This effort is nothing less than a miracle straight from the heart of God who brought all these elements together as only He can do.
