Good Samaritan – June – This month’s recipient of the Good Samaritan Fund is Brad Wolf. Brad is a dedicated member of the Tyrone Elks Lodge 212 Veterans Service Committee and has made a significant impact through his service and support of our local veterans.

On April 27, Brad was seriously injured in an ATV accident, suffering a skull fracture, a broken neck, and a partial spinal cord injury. He was life-flighted to UPMC Presbyterian in Pittsburgh, where he underwent surgery for his neck and skull fractures. Following his hospitalization, Brad spent several weeks at Mercy Rehabilitation in Pittsburgh and has made remarkable progress in a short amount of time. In early June, Brad was accepted into the Cleveland VA Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation Program, where he continues to work hard and make great strides in his recovery. Please keep Brad and his family in your thoughts and prayers as he continues his road to recovery.
